ASSISTANCE FOR INDIVIDUALS LIVING WITH CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE (CKD)

Individuals are eligible for general or dental assistance funds based on a diagnosis of kidney disease, treatment protocols of dialysis or movement towards transplant, and low-income status.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS

Mount Baker Foundation can provide temporary support for costs of housing, utilities, insurance premiums or prescriptions.

DENTAL ASSISTANCE

Mount Baker Foundation can pay for eligible individuals, including work necessary to get a clean bill of oral health for transplant!

POST-TRANSPLANT OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES

While Medicare / Medicaid and most insurance plans cover transplantation, there can be non-covered costs for temporary housing near the transplant center after transplant, and other similar costs.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Chronic Kidney Disease can change the course of one's life. Often, new career paths must be chosen that suit the needs of the individual at different stages of the journey. Mount Baker Foundation offers scholarship support for individuals who qualify.

Mount Baker Foundation also offers scholarships for those serving individuals with Chronic Kidney Disease and want to upgrade their skills and education, or who are just starting out on a caregiving career committed to those with Chronic Kidney Disease.
